This current includes acting as Lead on Digital Inclusion and development of initiatives to develop construction sector Apprenticeships and other opportunities but will vary according to the needs of the district.

Adult and Community Learning Courses support Kirklees residents aged 19+ to find their potential and update their skills. Adult and Community Learning is an Ofsted regulated provision that has been graded ' Good '

- Ensure project risks are identified and mitigated.
- Carry out effective line management and development of project staff.
