An apprenticeship with Kirklees Council will help you on your journey to grow your career alongside working towards a qualification. As a Forestry Apprentice you will be required to complete 30 month training programme that will cover all aspects of the role and will be delivered through attendance and blended learning delivered by a registered training provider.

You will learn skills to be able to look after and maintain trees including planting, pruning, and cutting down trees of all sizes within Kirklees including use of chainsaws and climbing trees

We are committed to recruiting a diverse workforce and would welcome applications from underrepresented groups.

Job Purpose

You will work as an Apprentice Arborist in the Forestry Team, part of the Greenspace Service. You will be required to complete a 30-month training programme that will cover all aspects of the role and will be delivered through attendance at college or other distance learning methods delivered by the training provider. You will complete an Arborist Apprenticeship Level 2.





College attendance and successful completion of these studies is an essential requirement of this Apprenticeship.

As part of this Apprenticeship, you will have to successfully complete the following training to achieve the full apprenticeship:

- Level 3 award in emergency first aid at work
- Level 2 award in safe use of brushwood chipper
- Traffic Management (NRSWA Unit 002 Signing, Lighting and Guarding) OR Sector Scheme 12D
- Level 2 award in chainsaw maintenance
- Level 2 award in crosscutting timber using a chainsaw
- Level 2 award in felling and processing trees up to 380mm
- Level 2 award in accessing a tree using a rope and harness
- Level 3 award in aerial tree rescue operations
- Level 3 award in aerial cutting of trees using free fall techniques
- Level 2 award in safe use of mobile elevated work platform
- Level 3 award in use of a chainsaw from a Mobile Elevated Work Platform (MEWP)
- All the training will be delivered and assessed by the training provider
