## OUR SCHOOLS



Ethos College provides long term full time education places for Key Stage 4 pupils (ages 14 to 16) with wide ranging Social, Emotional Mental Health (SEMH) needs. Additional 1:1 teaching is also available for a small number of pupils across Key Stages 1 to 4 who are referred with medical needs or for those whose needs are more complex.

Our mission at Ethos College is to create a secure and stimulating learning environment in which all students are valued and respected, their learning is promoted and their strengths are nurtured. Our focus is to prepare young people for transition to post-16 education, employment or training.



We are committed to improving the life chances of pupils barriers to engagement and achievement. Our aim is to creat inspiring environment where every child is empowered to take their learning and their futures.

igage Academy is a school for primary aged children ages I and 2 (ages 4-11) who are at risk of permanent exclusion and cor are rmanently excluded from a mainstream school. A high percentage of our ildren have Social, Emotional Mental Health (SEMH) needs along with idiagnosed complex needs. All pupils are assessed whilst with us and the ajority receive an Educational Health and Care Plan (EHCP) prior to going their next school ensuring their needs are met in the future.

e offer a nurturing, safe, inclusive and friendly environment where the illding of trusting relationships is paramount. We have a broad, creative rriculum that enables all pupils, regardless of need to achieve their tential and thrive in their new schools.
