The main purpose of this role is to present and serve in excess of 50 main meals and sweet items in our busy school kitchens. It is essential that meals are presented to the highest standards and delivery deadlines are achieved.

The post holder will complete all relevant paperwork and order meals on a daily basis.

You will be responsible for the achievement of legislative, financial and quality targets within your kitchen and will contribute to the development of these targets.

The post holder will ensure that high standards of cleanliness in the kitchen and dining room are maintained at all times.

You will provide support & guidance to Catering Assistants to ensure service standards are maintained; reporting any personnel issues to your manager.

Ensure that our customers are satisfied with our service, being friendly and helpful at all times and dealing with any complaints raised by customers.

Observing all relevant Service and Council policies and taking part in training activities to support the development of yourself and the team.

This is a physically demanding job which involves heavy lifting and long periods of standing in a hot, fast paced environment.
