Job Purpose

Highways Service focus on maintaining and improving Kirklees roads and pavements, improving safety, supporting local communities and economies whilst encouraging environmentally friendly travel. You will contribute to providing effective engineering or technical services that improve the lives of customers.

Working as an Apprentice Civil Engineering Technician you will be part of our Civil Engineering Apprentice Engineer Programme. As part of our programme, apprentices move around the different departments in Highways learning lots of different roles whilst also learning at college.

You will complete a 3 year Civil Engineering Technician Apprenticeship Level 3. College attendance and successful completion of these studies is an essential requirement of this

Apprenticeship that covers all aspects of the role and delivered by Leeds College of Building. On completion of the apprenticeship you will have satisfied the requirements for registration as an Engineering Technician by the relevant professional engineering institution qualification.

You will learn and put into practice a broad range of civil engineering skills as well as project management and engagement and consultation required for roles within the Highways Service. The role is to provide technical support to engineers and other construction professionals in the design, development, construction and maintenance of the built environment.

Working towards a level 3 Civil Engineering Technician can lead to a career in civil engineering.

Key areas of Responsibility

As an apprentice engineer you will move around different teams in the Service learning the following skills:

- **Design** – assist in the development of technical solutions by producing design models, calculations, reports and drawings, surveying a site and using appropriate analysis
- **Analysis** – using appropriate software systems and other data gathering tools and tests to solve technical problems
- **Project Delivery** – contributing to planning, managing work schedules, budgets and deadlines making sure there is compliance with industry specifications, standards and guidance
- **Site engineering** – operating quality systems and Health, Safety and Risk Management Procedures and checking technical aspects of site activities
