Our Greenspace Service, Grounds Maintenance Team provide a service that focuses on maintaining and improving greenspaces and open spaces across Kirklees.

Job Purpose

You will work as a Horticulture Apprentice with the Grounds Maintenance Teams who are part of the Greenspace Service. You will be required to complete a 30-month training programme that will cover all aspects of the role and will be delivered through attendance at college or other distance learning methods delivered by the training provider. You will complete a Horticulture Operative Level 2 Apprenticeship

College attendance and successful completion of these studies is an essential requirement of this Apprenticeship.





You will work as part of a team of experienced staff, maintaining Greenspace such as parks, housing estates, schools, and playing fields, across the Kirklees district that improve the lives of people living and travelling in our area.

As part of the Apprenticeship, you will be required to achieve the following additional qualifications before the end point assessment:

- Emergency First Aid at Work level 3 award
- Safe handling and application of Pesticides level 2

Key areas of Responsibility

The job includes undertaking the following duties,

- You will work with experienced staff in undertaking horticultural maintenance and to develop practical skills.
- You will receive the training for your apprenticeship through college and on the job work experience from experienced staff.
- You will have the opportunity to learn to mark out sports facilities, including Football, Rugby, Cricket, and athletics.
- If you have a full driving licence you have the opportunity to train to drive a ride on mower, and take the Kirklees driving assessment which if successful would enable you to drive council vehicles.
