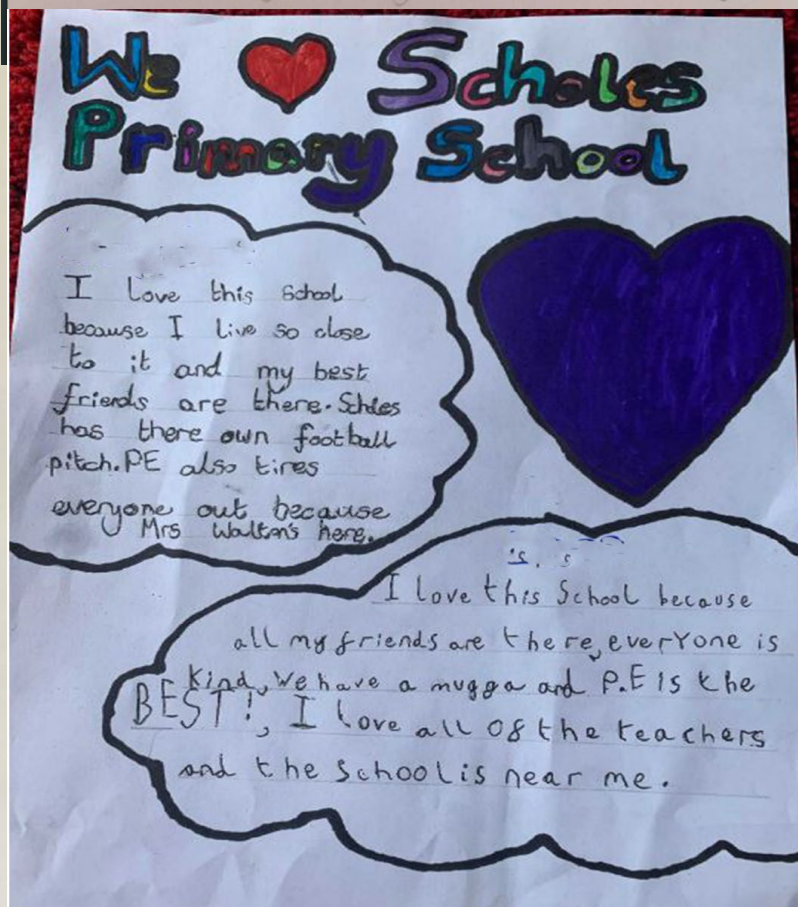
What is it that makes Scholes school so amazing?
