Purpose of the post:

To provide a whole school reprographics service in the design and production of materials

- To reproduce documents in house format
- To provide and maintain accurate records
- Assist with administration tasks in liaison with the Communication and Marketing Manager

Key responsibilities

Reprographics and resources

- To be responsible for all reprographics requirements within the school, including photocopying, laminating, collating and stapling
- To ensure documents are presented appropriately, on time and in line with the school's quality standards
- To control and maintain stock levels for all reprographics machines
- Plan and prioritise own workload
- Organise maintenance of machines
- Maintain accurate records of all reprographic work undertaken so that curriculum areas can be charged accordingly
- Assist curriculum areas in determining value for money with reprographics requests
- Be aware of current copyright legislation and general data protection regulation (GDPR)
 relating to photocopying and reprographics, and maintain records as required

Health and Safety

- To take general responsibility for the upkeep and maintenance of all reprographics equipment to ensure in good working order
- To assist in carrying out routine health and safety checks on reprographics equipment and reporting faults to the Business Manager
- Ensure that reprographics areas are kept tidy and safe

• Support School in the provision of first aid to staff and students (training will be provided)

Administration

- To assist in the receipt of, and checking of deliveries and associated invoices
- To assist in the maintenance of appropriate equipment inventory and cataloguing system for all stock
- To safely store and secure all equipment and stock
- To assist in organising the repair or replacement of reprographics and other equipment in consultation with the Business Manager

General

- As part of your wider duties and responsibilities you are required to promote and actively support Honley High School and the Together Learning Trust responsibilities towards safeguarding.
- Carry out your duties with due regard to current and future Honley High School and the Together Learning Trust policies, procedures and relevant legislation.
