Thank you for your interest in applying for the post of Year 6 teacher (1.0FTE) at Holmfirth Junior, Infant and Nursery School. We currently have just over 200 children on roll, including nursery provision.

Our key vision is twofold: Firstly, to promote the wellbeing of each individual, essential for the value of self, family, environment and diversity. Secondly, to provide a route to opportunity, enabling pupils to respond positively to challenges of rapidly changing world. Our intentions are to provide: opportunities for everyone to feel 'clever' or 'expert', opportunities for everyone to feel 'worthy' and opportunities for everyone to experience positive self-esteem. In order to achieve these intentions, we follow Kagan teaching principles, which support our intent for wellbeing by: being part of a team, providing a sense of belonging, using praise to develop confidence, appreciating of the qualities, knowledge and skills that others offer.

We have identified four key values which we believe should be at the heart of learning and at the heart of our curriculum: Communication, Collaboration, Curiosity and Creativity, which we refer to as 4C4Life.

We favour a collegiate approach, which we believe is essential to wellbeing, lifelong learning and the respecting and valuing of everybody. Within guidelines, staff are encouraged to be autonomous, creative, innovative and flexible. Making mistakes is part of excellent learning, therefore permission to take risks is granted. The sharing of good practice between staff members is a key feature of our practice – we are never too old to learn new tricks! We believe that this has secured a highly stable staffing situation.

If the need arises it is likely that interviews will take place via Skype.
