## Main purpose

The teacher will:

- Fulfil the professional responsibilities of a teacher, as set out in the School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document
- Meet the expectations set out in the Teachers' Standards

# **Duties and responsibilities**

## **Teaching**

- Create and manage a caring, supportive, purposeful and stimulating environment which is conducive to children's learning.
- Plan opportunities to develop the social, emotional and cultural aspects of pupils' learning.
- Plan and teach well-structured lessons that are exciting, engaging and give consideration to the most appropriate learning environment.
- Assess, monitor, record and report on the learning needs, progress and achievements of assigned pupils, making accurate and productive use of assessment.
- Adapt teaching to respond to the strengths and needs of pupils.
- Set high expectations which inspire, motivate and challenge pupils.
- Promote good progress and outcomes by pupils.
- Demonstrate good subject and curriculum knowledge.
- Participate in arrangements for preparing pupils for external tests.
- Design intervention and catch up sessions for identified pupils.

## Whole-school organisation, strategy and development

- Support the school's values and vision.
- Contribute to the development, implementation and evaluation of the school's policies, practices and procedures.

- Make a positive contribution to the wider life and ethos of the school.
- Work with others on curriculum and pupils' personal development to secure co-ordinated outcomes.
- Provide cover, in the unforeseen circumstance that another teacher is unable to teach.

#### Health, safety and discipline

- Promote the safety of pupils.
- Maintain good order and discipline among pupils, managing behaviour effectively to ensure a good and safe learning environment.
- Follow the schools behaviour policy including the use of positive behaviour and de-escalation strategies.
- Promote the Federation's values and British values through a wide range of opportunities.

### **Professional development**

- Take part in the school's appraisal procedures.
- Proactively take part in further training and development in order to improve own teaching.
- Where appropriate, take part in the appraisal and professional development of others.

#### Communication

- · Communicate effectively with pupils, parents and carers.
- Communicate effectively with colleagues across the whole Federation community.

#### Working with colleagues and other relevant professionals

- Collaborate and work with colleagues and other relevant professionals within and beyond the school.
- Develop effective professional relationships with colleagues.

### Personal and professional conduct

- Uphold public trust in the profession and maintain high standards of ethics and behaviour, within and outside school.
- Have proper and professional regard for the ethos, policies and practices of the school, and maintain high standards of attendance and punctuality.
- Understand and act within the statutory frameworks setting out their professional duties and responsibilities.

The teacher will be required to safeguard and promote the welfare of children and young people, and follow school policies and the staff code of conduct.
