Thank you for showing an interest in our Educational Teaching Assistant vacancy. We are very proud of our school, our pupils and their success.

Our committed teaching and support staff strive to bring out the best in our children and equip them with the skills they will need for the future. We place great emphasis upon the well being and personal development of every child and encourage them to be well behaved & tolerant with a sense of responsibility for others and the environment.

About the School

Reinwood Infant and Nursery is a larger than average community school for children aged 3-7 years, currently with three Reception classes, three single age classes for Y1 and four for Y2, along with a 78 place Nursery. We share the school building with the Junior School, which occupies the floor above us and we have a formal partnership with them.

Pupils are predominantly from our immediate area but some travel from out of catchment. The school serves pupils from very mixed socio-economic backgrounds. It is very over-subscribed.

There are at present 308 children on roll organised into 10 single aged classes. The school site provides excellent indoor and outdoor facilities, including Forest School provision. On entry, a large number of children are below average in terms of their personal development, language and communication and knowledge and understanding of the world. An average number of pupils are entitled to free school meals. Around 45% of pupils are from an ethnic minority, mainly from Indian and Pakistani backgrounds, English is an additional language for approximately 26% of these pupils. A below average number of pupils have special needs, these include some with physical or other specific learning needs. A number of pupils have an EHCP.

Pupils across school achieve particularly well and many reach well above average standards for their age. In short, Reinwood I&N is a highly successful school with several outstanding features.

Staffing comprises of Head, Deputy, Inclusion Manager and 10 FTE teachers. In addition there is a wide range of admin and classroom support (including special needs). The school also benefits from a very supportive governing body and parents who positively support their children's learning.

We are now looking to appoint an enthusiastic, dedicated Educational Teaching Assistant to join our supportive team, who will maintain our high standards.
