If you have an interest in asbestos, and would like to learn how it is surveyed, where it can be found, risk assessed, and managed in our properties, consider our compliance apprenticeship programme.

You'll receive tailored on-the-job training from our in-house experts, combined with early responsibility to help you develop and progress. You'll be working towards a nationally recognised qualification – a Level 3 in the Built Environment.

The Compliance (Asbestos) apprenticeship will combine on-the-job learning with a programme of training and development. Your role might involve:

- Being aware of new asbestos management legislation and how that will affect our business.
- Assist the Technical Officers (Asbestos) in ensuring that appropriate Asbestos Survey information is available before works are undertaken, and if not, that relevant surveys are commissioned with external contractors.
- Assist the Technical Officers (Asbestos) in ensuring that all Asbestos Surveys received are subject to quality assurance checks, with issues logged for discussion as part of contract performance management meetings. This will include quality assurance visits on site to audit survey results.
- Assist the Technical Officers (Asbestos) and Surveyor (Asbestos) in the management and delivery
 of the asbestos re-inspection programme to communal areas and domestic properties, and the
 update of the Asbestos Management software with the inspection information.



- Assist the Technical Officers (Asbestos) and Surveyor (Asbestos) in maintaining a programme of quality assurance checks of asbestos removal works.
- Assist the Property Assistant (Compliance) in updating the Asbestos Register with new survey information, removals and encapsulation works.

To be eligible for our Compliance apprenticeship programme, you will need:

- To be:
 - Enthusiastic
 - Hard working
 - Punctual
 - Committed
 - Able to work as part of a team and individually
- Basic IT Skills
- Good communication skills
- Qualifications
 - to have achieved or be working towards 5 GCSE's or equivalent at grade 5 (A* C) and above, including Maths and English (not literature), as well as having knowledge to level 1 equivalent for commonly used office computer applications

As part of the selection process, you may be assessed on the following:

- Levels of literacy and numeracy
- Levels of achievement in any specific trade entry assessments
- Participation in a practical taster session
- Ability to learn, both in a classroom setting and on-site

We may also need to do further checks before we offer you a placement, for example for criminal convictions, safeguarding and health screening.
